We will get a behind the scenes look at how they go about creating their fantastic pottery. See the processes from making, adding special effects glazing, everything... the works! We will board a 30-passenger bus at Lakeside Presbyterian Church on Wednesday morning, October 13 at around 9:30 am. Then the adventure begins. We will have two guided tours of 15 people each. After the tour and gift shop, we board the bus again around 12:15, to go to Taft's Ale House for lunch. We will order from the menu and get individual checks.
